Tackling the climate crisis with **courage** is not only necessary but also a great opportunity to make our economy and society more people-oriented and therefore more **forward-looking**. The **challenge of climate crisis** can be an opportunity to set our country in motion for the sake of a common and better future.

However, we will work along these lines as much as we can, leaving no one behind, leaving no one alone. An Italy that makes Italy, starting from our finest traditions, is vital to this challenge and can give a significant contribution in trying to build a **civilised**, **kind world**.
